Autism Awareness (Children) AM - Tutor: Jeremy Brigham

Part of our Schools Support Staff Summer School, this half day session looks at recognising and supporting school children with autism. Great for any TAs or schools support staff.

The tutor for this session is Jez Brigham, he is currently Deputy Head of a special school and has had a broad career working at a primary school and children with SEN. He has developed strategies for dealing with extremely challenging behaviour and has delivered training to education teams and teachers.

Dealing with Violence in Schools PM - Tutor: Jeremy Brigham
